




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## EIS – Response to submissions



- Our 'Response to Submissions' was lodged with the Department of Planning Industry and Environment on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020, and subsequently published by the Department.
- This is our response to 30 submissions sent to the Environmental Impact Statement, including:
  - · 15 from public authorities
  - 9 from organisations and agencies
  - · 6 from members of the community
- We engaged in 43 interactions between AGL and respondents from January to April, including:
  - In person face-to-face meetings (pre-COVID-19)
  - Teleconferences
  - Emails
  - Letters
  - · Phone calls, and
  - 14 remote face-to-face (Skype)

## **Newcastle Gas Storage Facility**

## -agl

#### General

- The plant has completed liquification in March.
- · Tank filled to 95% of its capacity.
- AGL is ready for the increase in customer demand in autumn leading into winter.
- COVID-19 slowed down all maintenance and capital project activities.
- We have been mainly in HOLDING mode since March due to COVID-19 and low demand in gas market.
- Several plant critical process safety tests completed and routine inspection and maintenance carried out during the HOLDING mode.
- New vibration monitoring system installed and commissioned on the main compressor. This will give us enough notice prior any major damage to the compressor.
- SafeWork NSW MHF Division have completed their audit on the 28<sup>th</sup> February.
- We received three administrative notifications and addressed them before the due date.
- Building a new warehouse is in progress. The warehouse will be used to store NGSF critical spare parts, motors, shafts, small pipes, flanges, gaskets, nuts, bolts, etc.



## **Newcastle Gas Storage Facility**

#### **Environmental Update**

- Air Emissions testing was undertaken on H-101 Unit in April with no exceedance reported.
- 6-monthly groundwater and surface water monitoring was undertaken in March with no exceedance reported
- Air Emissions testing being undertaken on F-501A, B & C Heaters in June/July.
- National Pollution Inventory (NPI) and Sustainability Data being collated and submitted at the end of July.





## Local Community Investment Program FY 2020



- Once COVID-19 restrictions were put in place, potential recipients of the Local Community Investment Program (LCIP) advised that their initiatives had been indefinitely postponed or cancelled.
- The LCIP will resume in the new financial year 2021, with updated guidelines that will reflect federal, state and internal HSE measures to stop the spread of COVID-19.
- The first round of LCIP grants in the new financial year is expected to take place in August 2021.
- Conscious of the negative impacts that the pandemic has placed on our community's most vulnerable people, AGL proceeded to engage stakeholders in search of initiatives that make a difference in these difficult times.
