Galilee Energy Operations Update

Galilee Energy Limited (Galilee) is involved in two permits, ATP529P and ATP799P, in the Galilee Basin with significant Coal Seam Gas (CSG) potential. Galilee is a 68% owned subsidiary of Eastern Corporation Limited. The current operational activity in those permits is as follows:-

ATP 529P – AGL Operator

The 2009 **drilling** programme in ATP 529P commenced with Muttaburra-02, which was the first of 7 core holes scheduled to be drilled across the tenement.

The second core hole, Vera Park-01, was completed on 8 December.

The third core hole, Crossmore South-01, spudded 10 December, is currently suspended due to wet weather.

The 2009 2D **seismic** programme of a 540 kilometre survey is now complete.

ATP 529 P is held jointly by AGL Energy Limited (50%) and Galilee (50%) in a farmin agreement under which AGL is the operator.

ATP 799P - Galilee Operator

Galilee's 2009 **drilling** programme, consisting of Dunrossie-01 and Dotswood-01 core holes, completed in February, after a short delay due to wet weather.

The 2009 2D seismic programme of a 150 kilometre survey is now complete.

ATP 799P is 100% owned by Galilee.

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
