Service Stream secures new Metering Field Services Agreement

Leading essential network services company Service Stream Limited (ASX: SSM) is pleased to announce that it has entered into a new metering field services contract with Active Stream, an Australian metering services business, which is a wholly owned subsidiary of AGL Energy Limited.

Under the contract, Service Stream's Energy & Water division will provide Active Stream with a range of installation, commissioning, maintenance, logistics and customer contact center services. The contract has an initial term of three years, with the option of two one-year extensions.

Whilst the new agreement does not provide guaranteed volumes, Service Stream estimates aggregate revenue may be in excess of \$50 million over the initial term.
